We've enjoyed a great 2018 season with the men's senior team making their first grand final in 28 years, the Under 19's also making the grand final, our netball under 17 team playing off for a grand final birth and the other netball teams consolidating strong performances as we build into next season. Our women's team enjoyed some long awaited success on the back of a change of coaching personnel. Off the field we finally got our website in order, we've recruited long term major sponsors and experienced record numbers in our Coaches Club which has been set up to fund the cost of all Club coaching and training functions. We estimate the amount raised through the contributions of Coaches Club members this year to be in excess of \$55,000. All of this has helped lead to a surplus this year sufficient to cover last year's shortfall and to put funds aside for infrastructure improvements associated with the installation of the new netball courts and oval lights over the summer.

My thanks go out on behalf of the whole Club to the hard work of the Committee and our many volunteers who have helped create a safe and welcoming playing environment at Red Hill for the 85 males and 79 females who participated in the 9 teams we fielded this year. All at the Club are looking forward to next season as we not only chase those elusive premierships but also build on and enhance the enviable community based culture we all enjoy at Red Hill.

Welcome aboard Dean, Stef & Jayda.


KYLE BEVERIDGE
